

## Dress Code Standards for Boys and Young Men

Item	Style	Description
Polo shirts	Long-sleeved or short-sleeved polo's with a collar.	The shirts must be solid colored – of <b>any color</b> and free of lettering, patterns or stripes. A small (no more than one inch in size) manufacturer's insignia may appear on the chest.
Dress shirts	Long-sleeved or short-sleeved oxford cloth with a collar.	The shirts must be <b>white or blue</b> , solid colors free of lettering, patterns or stripes. Shirts must be tucked in neatly with belt visible for students in Grades 5 thru 12.
Slacks/shorts	Dress/cargo slacks and shorts, pleated or flat front. Shorts are to be walking length (may not be worn December through March).	<b>Navy blue, black or khaki tan</b> (all cotton or cotton/poly blend – no denim) solid colors with no holes and no stitching on back pockets. No rivets or carpenter loops; no rolled cuff. Must not be ripped, split or frayed. Must be worn with belt (Grades 5 thru 12) unless the slacks/shorts have elastic waist bands.
Sweaters	V-neck, crew neck or cardigan sweaters and/or vests.	<b>Navy blue, dark hunter green, red, black, white, yellow, light green or light blue.</b> Sweaters must be solid colored and free of lettering, patterns or stripes. A small (no more than one inch in size) manufacturer's insignia may appear on the chest.
Turtlenecks	Long- or short-sleeved mock or fold-over style.	<b>Navy blue, dark hunter green, red, black, white, yellow, light green or light blue.</b> The turtleneck must be solid colored and free of lettering, patterns or stripes. A small (no more than one inch in size) manufacturer's insignia may appear on the chest.
Sweatshirts	Hooded or crew neck are permitted to be worn over school uniform shirts.	<b>Navy blue, dark hunter green, red, black, white, yellow, light green or light blue.</b> The sweatshirt must be solid colored and free of lettering, patterns or stripes. A small (no more than one inch in size) manufacturer's insignia may appear on the chest.
Shoes	Dress shoes, tennis shoes or sandals.	No flip flops or slides are permitted.
Belts: this standard applies to students in Grades 5 thru 12	Must be worn at all times unless pants/shorts have elastic waistband.	Solid <b>black, brown, gray or white.</b>
T-shirts	Long-sleeved or short-sleeved crew neck shirts are permitted under uniform shirts. They are not to be worn as a uniform shirt.	Cotton or poly blend <b>navy blue, dark hunter green, red, black, white, yellow, light green or light blue.</b> No print should be visible through outer wear. No thermal underwear.
Hair and Facial Hair	Well-groomed hair with no extremes in style or color. No facial hair permitted.	Hair length not to extend beyond collars. Young men should be clean shaven.
Other Items	Tattoos, piercings, hats, caps, sunglasses.	No visible tattoos (permanent or temporary/play) are permitted; hats, caps and sunglasses are not to be worn in the school building. Jewelry is not permitted in body piercings.

***The Agape logo, in its standard size, may appear on any of the shirts/sweatshirts/sweaters in the dress code.***

***When purchasing Agape apparel, printing can be placed on the back of the garment. This can include words such as student names, Agape sports teams and graduation years. Review the words with your Campus Administrator prior to making a decision about the words.***

## Dress Code Standards for Girls and Young Women

Item	Style	Description
Polo shirts and polo collared dresses	Long-sleeved or short-sleeved polo's with a collar or a polo dress with a collar long or short sleeved.	The shirts/dresses must be solid colored – of <b>any color</b> and free of lettering, patterns or stripes. A small (no more than one inch in size) manufacturer's insignia may appear on the chest.
Blouses	Long-sleeved or short-sleeved oxford cloth with a collar.	The blouses must be <b>white or blue</b> , solid colors free of lettering, patterns or stripes. Blouses must be tucked in neatly with belt visible for students in Grades 5 thru 12. Top blouse button may be unbuttoned.
Skirts/skorts and jumpers	Neat and clean with no holes and modest fitting. Length no more than one inch above the knee in the front and the back but may be longer.	<b>Tan-khaki or navy blue</b> solid colors with no holes or stitching. If the length of the skirt, skort or jumper is more than one inch above the knee, the student must wear leggings.
Pants	Full length dress or cargo pants (boot leg or flare), capris or crops. May be pleated or flat front, no rolled slacks, leggings (except worn under skirts) or skinny or "yoga" pants.	<b>Navy blue, black or khaki tan</b> (all cotton or cotton/poly blend – no denim). No rivets or carpenter loops; no rolled cuffs. Must not be ripped, split or frayed. Must be worn with belt unless pants have an elastic waist band (Grades 5 thru 12).
Shorts	Walking length shorts, no shorter than three inches above the top of the knee (may not be worn Dec. thru March).	<b>Navy blue or khaki tan</b> (all cotton or cotton/poly blend). Must be worn with belt unless shorts have an elastic waist band.
Sweaters	V-neck, crew neck or cardigan sweaters and/or vests.	<b>Navy blue, dark hunter green, red, black, white, yellow, light green or light blue</b> . Sweaters must be solid colored and free of lettering, patterns or stripes. A small (no more than one inch in size) manufacturer's insignia may appear on the chest.
Turtlenecks	Long- or short-sleeved mock or fold-over style.	<b>Navy blue, dark hunter green, red, black, white, yellow, light green or light blue</b> . The turtlenecks must be solid colored and free of lettering, patterns or stripes. A small (no more than one inch in size) manufacturer's insignia may appear on the chest.
Sweatshirts	Hooded or crew neck are permitted to be worn over school uniform shirts.	<b>Navy blue, dark hunter green, red, black, white, yellow, light green or light blue</b> . The sweatshirts must be solid colored and free of lettering, patterns or stripes. A small (no more than one inch in size) manufacturer's insignia may appear on the chest.
Shoes	Dress shoes, tennis shoes or sandals.	No flip flops or slides are permitted.
Tights	Leggings/tights that are worn under skirts. Tights/leggings are not to be worn as pants.	Can be patterned and of any color.
Belts: applies to Grades 5 thru 12	Must be worn with pants and shorts that have belt loops.	Solid black, brown, gray or white. To be worn in belt loops only.
T-shirts	Long-sleeved or short-sleeved crew neck shirts are permitted under uniform shirts.	Cotton or poly blend <b>navy blue, dark hunter green, red, black, white, yellow, light green or light blue</b> . No print should be visible through outer wear. No thermal underwear.
Hair	No extreme in hairstyle or coloring; this includes colors other than natural hair colors; blond highlights are acceptable.	Headbands and hair clips are permitted. No head scarves, colored or decorative hair extensions, or feathers.
Other	Makeup, tattoos, piercings, hats, caps, sunglasses.	No visible tattoos permitted; hats, caps and sunglasses are not to be worn in the school building. No makeup except for light foundation, clear nail polish and clear lip gloss. Jewelry is not permitted in body piercings except for in one piercing in each ear.

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
